



**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF HUDSPETH COUNTY, TEXAS  
EXTENDING A DISASTER DECLARATION DUE TO A PUBLIC  
HEALTH EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY HUDSPETH COUNTY, TEXAS**

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2020, an emergency ordinance of Hudspeth County, Texas was issued due to a public health emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, that emergency ordinance stated that it would remain in effect until rescinded by the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court; and


**WHEREAS**, Governor Greg Abbott has issued an executive order lifting some of the restrictions previously imposed on citizens of the State of Texas.


**NOW THEREFORE, AFTER HAVING RECEIVED A UNANIMOUS TELECONFERENCE VOTE OF THE HUDSPETH COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF HUDSPETH COUNTY, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the aforesaid emergency ordinance is hereby rescinded and the attached copy of Governor Abbott's Executive Order is hereby unanimously adopted.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance is adopted with the unanimous vote of the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court and the consent of the Hudspeth County Judge and shall become effective on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 2020.
