



**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF HUDSPETH COUNTY, TEXAS
EXTENDING A DISASTER DECLARATION DUE TO A PUBLIC
HEALTH EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY HUDSPETH COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas issued a proclamation certifying that COVID-19 poses an imminent threat of disaster in the state and declaring a state of disaster for all counties in Texas; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020 the Hudspeth County Judge signed a Declaration of Local State of Disaster pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 418.108; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization Director General urged aggressive preparedness and activation, of emergency plans to aggressively change the trajectory of this pandemic; and

WHEREAS, section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; and


WHEREAS, the condition necessitating a Declaration of Local State of Disaster continues to exist.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF
HUDSPETH COUNTY, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1. That the state of disaster proclaimed by the Hudspeth County Judge on March 20, 2020 shall be extended and continue until terminated by the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is adopted as an emergency measure with the unanimous vote of the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court and the consent of the Hudspeth County Judge and shall become effective on the 27th day of March 2020.
