### ORDER NO. 2026.002

#### **DETERMINING NECESSITY OF A COUNTY AUDITOR AND CERTIFYING THE NEED FOR APPOINTMENT OF A JOINT COUNTY AUDITOR**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Hudspeth County, Texas, is charged with the efficient, lawful, and transparent disposition of county business; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the scope, complexity, and volume of county financial operations require professional oversight to ensure proper accounting, compliance, and fiscal integrity; and

WHEREAS, Texas law provides that when the Commissioners Court determines an auditor is necessary in the disposition of county business, the Court shall enter an order stating such necessity and certify the order to the district judges having jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Hudspeth County is within the jurisdiction of the Honorable District Judges of the 205th Judicial District Court and the 394th Judicial District Court; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has further determined that the appointment of a joint county auditor would best serve the interests of the county and promote efficient administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Hudspeth County, Texas, that the Court hereby finds and determines that a county auditor is necessary in the disposition of county business.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Commissioners Court declares the necessity of appointing a joint county auditor.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the County Judge is authorized and directed to certify this order to the Honorable Francisco Dominguez, Judge of the 205th Judicial District Court, and the Honorable Monte Kimball, Judge of the 394th Judicial District Court, for consideration and action in accordance with applicable law.
