Texas Juvenile Justice & Youth Diversion Grant Program (JJ-YD) - FY2027

WHEREAS, the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hudspeth County that the Teen Court Juvenile Services Project be operated for the 2027 fiscal year; and


WHEREAS, Hudspeth County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor's funds, Hudspeth County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court designates the Hudspeth County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the Hudspeth County Commissioners Court designates the Hudspeth County Auditor as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.


