Texas Constitution – Article 3 Section 52f
{Added November 4, 1980; Amended November 3, 2015}

PRIVATE ROAD WORK BY CERTAIN COUNTIES. A County with a population of 7,500 or less, according to the most recent federal census, **may construct and maintain private roads** if it imposes a reasonable charge for the work. The Legislature by general law may limit this authority. Revenue received from private road work may be used **only** for the construction, including right-of-way acquisition, or maintenance of public roads.
