**DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DUE TO WILDFIRE**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Hudspeth has the potential of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from wild fires further spread by recent drought, and high winds, and

**WHEREAS**, the County Judge Thomas D. Neely of Hudspeth County has determined that some measures must be taken to protect our people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY** the County Judge Thomas D. Neely of Hudspeth County: That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Hudspeth County pursuant to §418.001 of the Texas Government Code.


Pursuant to §418.001 of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Hudspeth County.

Pursuant to §418.001 of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.

Pursuant to §418.001 of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Hudspeth County emergency management plan.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
