FEMA Seeking Leaders for Youth Preparedness Council Applications

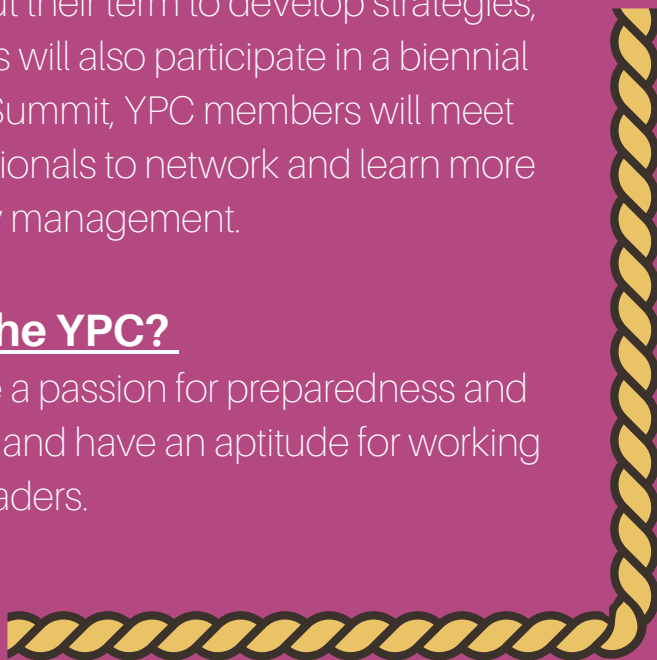
